Preparation and Application:

- Apply to new or freshly repainted booth.
- Make sure the windows and lights are clean and grease free.
- Small wrinkles and bubbles could cause losing adhesion properties.
- Film is treated for paint-adhesion.
- Remove by peeling the film from the wall layer by layer. Remove one layer after 250 booth cycles or 3 months, whichever comes first.
- It will be quite some time before you have used up all 4 layers of the film and need to reapply it.
- Easily removed without adhesive transferring.
- Perfectly in combination with Colad Blizzard White.
